## **Risk Management & Insurance Program at UC Denver Announces Courses for CE Learning Credits**

The Undergraduate Risk Management and Insurance (RMI) Program at the Business School, University of Colorado Denver invites industry professionals with undergraduate degrees to attend either or both of two RMI courses for Insurance Continuing Education (CE) Learning Credits. The "Introduction to Risk Management" course earns attendees 21 credits, 3 of which apply towards Ethics credit.
